Background

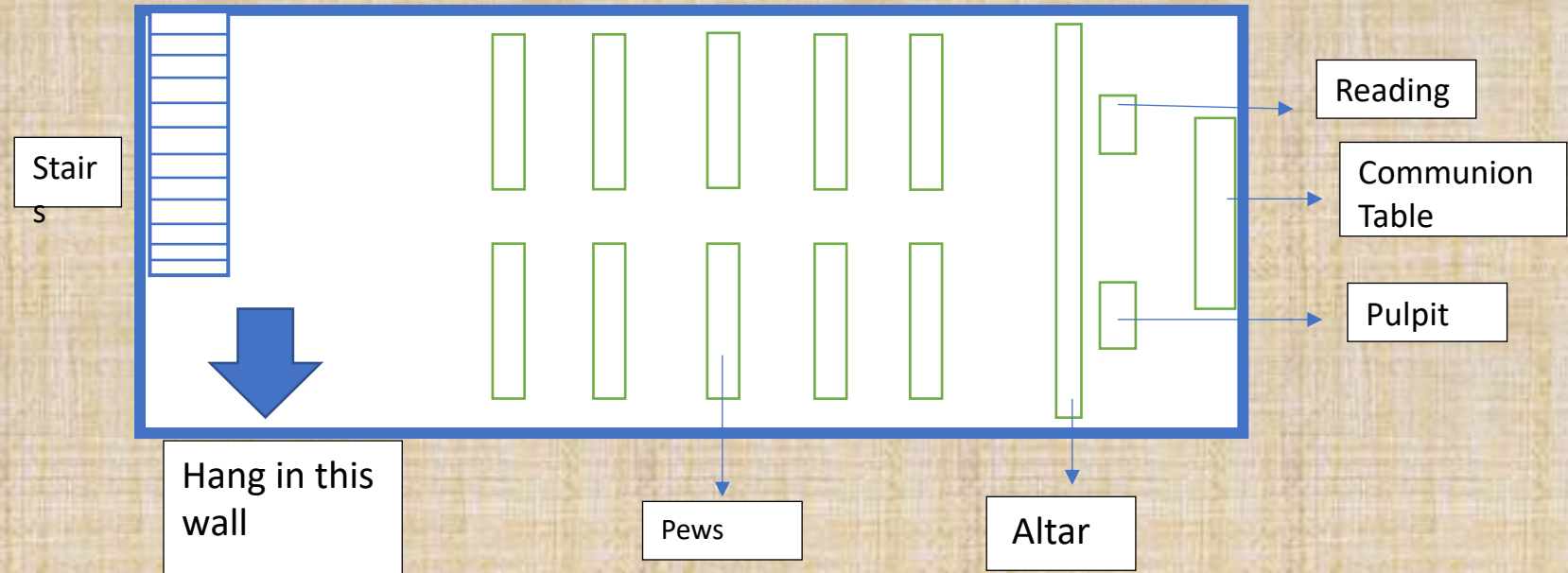
Is true that the map used here is not from the entire world, it represent our community in our local church.
